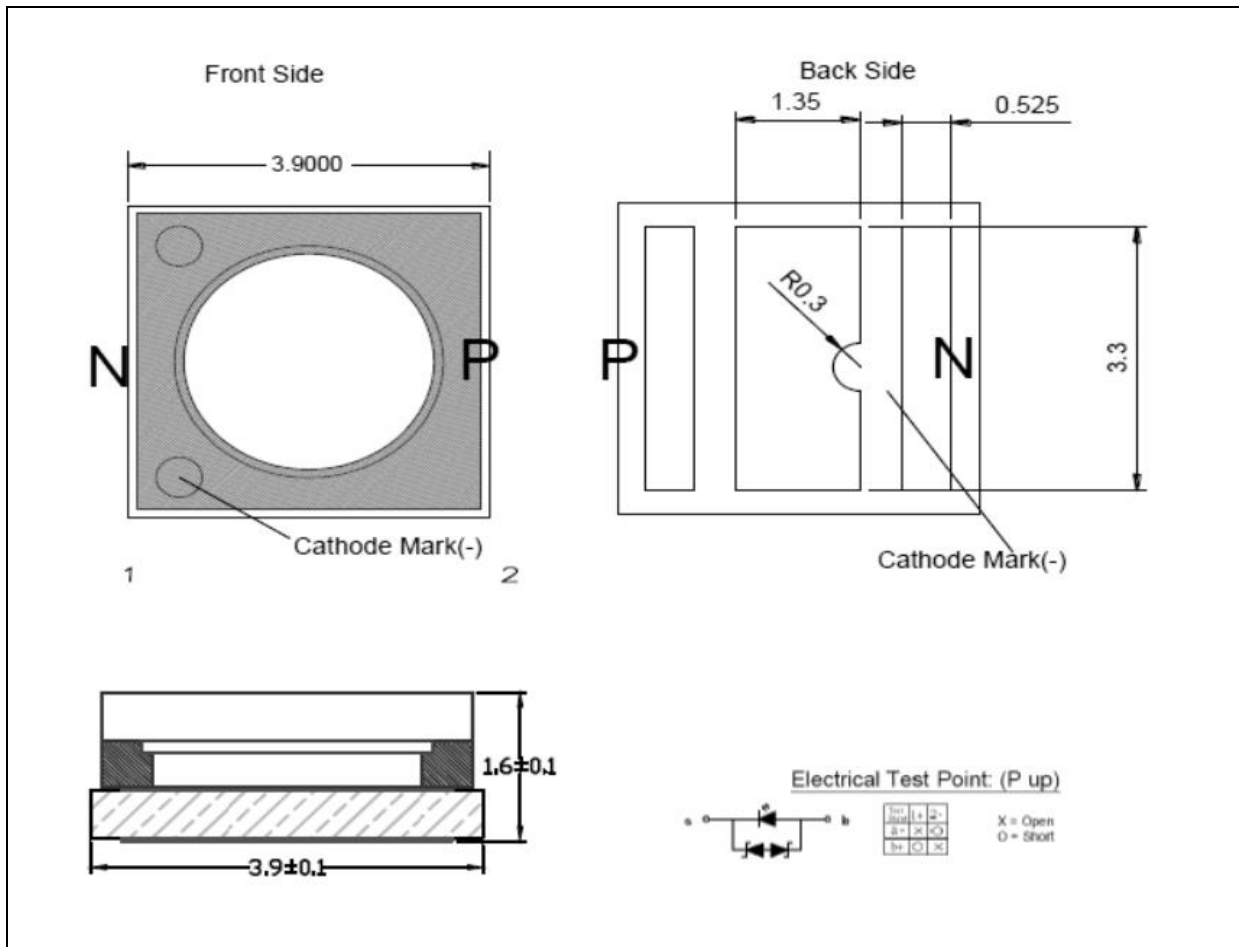

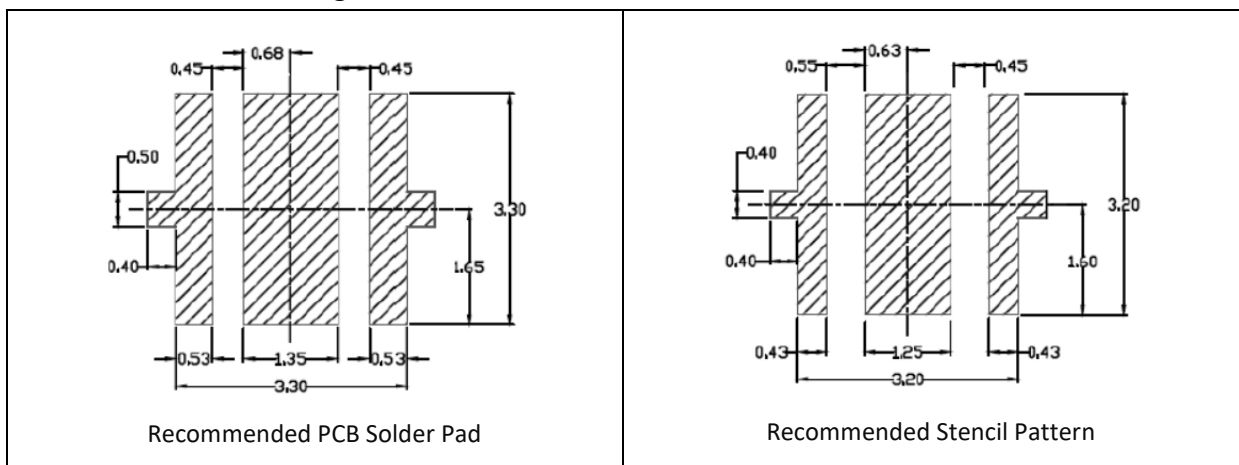

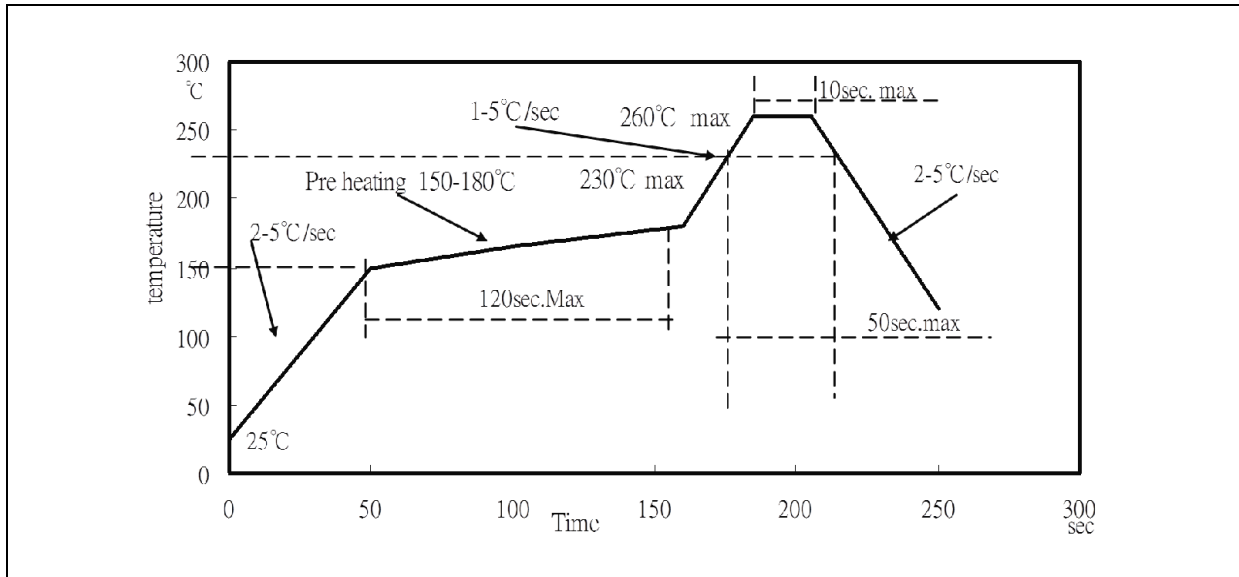

RECOMMENDED SOLDERING PROFILE:

Lead-free Solder:

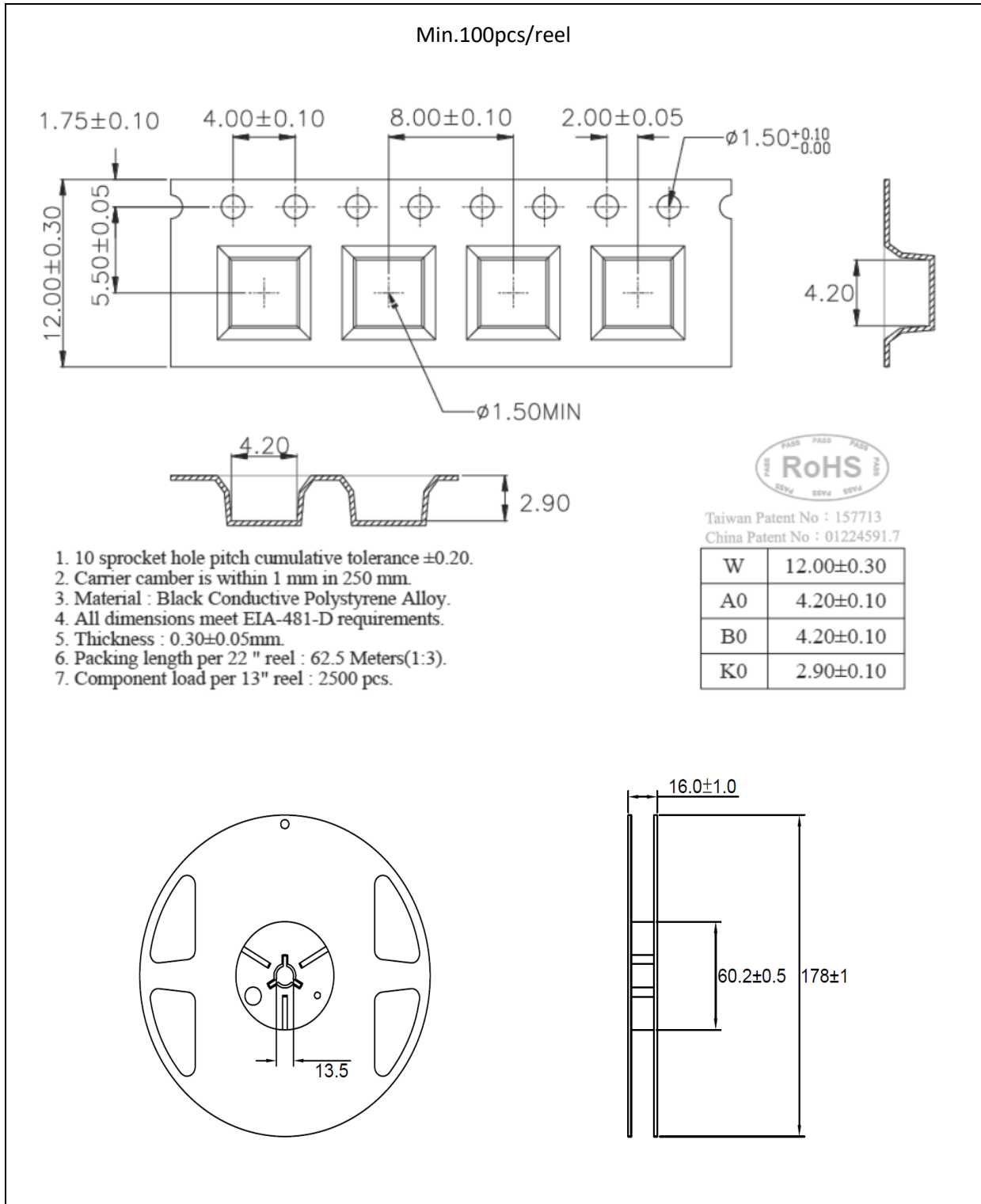


Note:

1. Maximum reflow soldering: 2 times.
2. Recommended reflow temperature 240°C. Maximum soldering temperature should be limited to 260°C.
3. Before, during, and after soldering, should not apply stress on the components and PCB board.

PRECAUTIONS OF USE:

Storage:

It is recommended to store the products in the following conditions:

- Humidity: 60% R.H. Max.
- Temperature: 5°C~30°C (41°F ~86°F).

Shelf life in sealed bag: 12 months at 5°C~30°C and <60% R.H.

Once the package is opened, the products should be used within a week. Otherwise, they should be kept in a damp-proof box with desiccating agent <10% R.H. and apply baking before use.

Baking:

It is recommended to bake the LED before soldering if the pack has been unsealed for longer than 24hrs.

The suggested baking conditions are as followings:

- 65±3°C x 12hrs and <5%RH, taped / reel package.

It's normal to see slight color fading of carrier (light yellow) after baking in process.

Testing Circuit:



Must apply resistor(s) for protection (over current proof).

Cleaning:

Use alcohol-based cleaning solvents such as isopropyl alcohol to clean the LED carrier / package. Avoid putting any stress force directly on to the LED lens.

ESD (Electrostatic Discharge):

Static Electricity or power surge will damage the LED. Use of a conductive wrist band or anti-electrostatic glove is recommended when handling the LED all time. All devices, equipment, machinery, work tables, and storage racks must be properly grounded.

In the events of manual working in process, make sure the devices are well protected from ESD at any time.
